The USF St. Pete 2025 Summer Academy for Investigative Learning (SAIL) is a 6-week program for undergraduate students. Meetings begin June 3 and typically be scheduled on Tuesdays/Thursdays; sessions will be hybrid, including in-person events, field trips, and virtual workshops. If selected, you will be expected to attend all 10 meetings as well as the Final Symposium on 7/23/25.

SAIL introduces undergraduate participants to the profound significance of research in our ever-evolving society, challenge them to confront local and global issues, and empower them to actively engage in research endeavors at USF and beyond.
